We serve people in the general community, including those of East Asian backgrounds. Every week, more than 8,500 families access our services and activities:



Aged Care Services

- Quality Residential Aged Care Facility (RACF) in Campsie and Asquith;
- Home Care Packages (HCP);
- Short Term Restorative Care (STRC);
- Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) & Miscellaneous Services:
 - Centre based respite, flexible respite, domestic assistance, personal care services and social support (group / individual) for seniors;
 - Handy Helping Hand (Triple H) Services;
 - Home Care Brokerage Services;
- Affordable hostel accommodation and independent living unit.





Disability Services

We are an NDIS Registered Service Provider for:

- Specialist Disability Accommodation (Group Homes);
- Supported Independent Living;
- Centre Based Day Program;
- Individual Supports: personal care, domestic assistance, transport, outings, etc.;
- Support Coordination;
- Plan Management;
- Carers Support Groups;
- Handy Helping Hands (Triple H)-Disability Services: a private service for non-NDIS participants (fees apply);
- NDIS access support service: free consultation on how to access NDIS.

Child Care Services

- Centre-Based Care: CASS Gumnut Early Learning Centres located in Campsie, Hurstville and St Leonards, long day care for children from birth to 5 years old;
- Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) Service: before/after school care and vacation care for primary school students;
- Family Day Care: child care and OSHC for children aged 6 weeks to 12 years, in the homes of trained and registered educators across various suburbs;
- Playgroup: support families who have children aged 0-5 years old to develop their social support network, enabling them to access various information and breaking social isolation.



Employment & Training Services

- Family Day Care: licence, training, support and supervision;
- Certificate III in Individual Support Course;
- Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care Course;
- First Aid Certificate Course;
- Work placement opportunity for students seeking relevant qualifications.

Settlement & Health Services

- Settlement Services: assist newly arrived Chinese, Korean and Vietnamese migrants with settlement concerns including housing, employment, education as well as health & welfare issues through face-to-face casework and referral services, hotline enquiry services and email (help@cass.org.au);
- Information Sessions and Expos;
- Form Filling and Smart Devices Support;
- Tax Help Services;
- Youth Services;
- Health Services: provide health information or resources to the community and promote healthy life styles.

Community Social Support Services

- Activity groups for seniors;
- Mental Health Services: H-Line Non-Crisis Hotline for Chinese-speaking people, information and sharing sessions;
- Volunteering Opportunities: we recruit and train volunteers to assist in many aspects of our operation. In particular, Aged Care Volunteer Visitors Scheme (ACVVS), Connect Call, facilitating volunteers to participate in the volunteering services.
- CACCA (CASS Aged Care Connect Assistance) & CASS Care Finder program.



Promotion of Chinese Language & Culture

- CASS Chinese School: Chinese language classes run in Campsie, Hurstville, Kogarah, Bexley and Connells Point, STEM programs, debating, public speaking, etc.;
- CASS Academy of Arts: ballet, creative arts, social dance, etc.;
- Cultural classes and groups: martial arts, lion dance, Tai Chi, calligraphy, etc.

Community Activities

- Running Environmental Care Teams;
- Youth Groups: social and sporting activities;
- Interest classes and groups: dancing, calligraphy, stamp collection, etc.
